Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or REALife Group.

1. How do you think pride and arrogance hinder leadership? Why is gratitude a key to happiness? See Philippians 4:4-8.
2. Do you tend to feel that the kingdom of God has arrived and that you should be enjoying it or that the kingdom is not yet here and you should be giving your life for it? How does your view affect your motivation?
3. Are you comfortable calling people to imitate you as Paul does in I Corinthians 4:16 and 11:1? How does Philippians 3:12-17 make this more palatable?
4. Are you more “talk” or more “power”? How are you seeing the power of God expressed in your life?
